# RESEARCH CONTIBUTIONS

### STATEMENT ON RESEARCH

- As a clinical academic my personal mission is to produce best research evidence to inform clinical practice and improve the quality of patient care.
- My first experience of postgraduate research was a human volunteer study to investigate the
  relationship between pain and anxiety. This involved the acquisition of numerous new skills
  ranging from the recruitment of subjects to the recording of somatosensory evoked potentials
  from median nerve stimulation and lead to the award of an MDS. I gained a thorough
  understanding of pain measurement and modulation.
- Further to my MDS research I gained experience of randomised controlled trials performed both independently and in collaboration with the pharmaceutical industry. I then undertook a laboratory scientific training in neuropsychopharmacology leading to the award of a PhD.
- I was subsequently awarded a Health Foundation Mid-Career Break Award that provided the opportunity for training in Cochrane Systematic Review writing and developing my health service research.
- I am particularly interested in how to translate best research evidence into everyday clinical practice and how to overcome the barriers that can prevent this.
- In the 2014 Research Exercise Framework (REF) the School of Dentistry in Manchester as
  part of the Unit of Assessment 3, UoA3, (Allied Health Professions, Dentistry, Nursing and
  Pharmacy) was judged to be number ONE of the 94 submissions from across the UK in terms
  of overall research performance including outputs, environment and impact. Within
  Manchester University U0A3 was one of the highest scoring.
- Since my appointment at Queen Mary University of London as Dean & Director of the Institute of Dentistry, in January 2019 the QS World University Rankings has escalated from more than 75<sup>th</sup> in the world to being ranked 11<sup>th</sup> in the world and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the UK in 2020 and 14<sup>th</sup> in 2021. The Ranking is based on an Overall Score composed of scores for Employer Reputation, H-Index Citations, Citations per Paper and Academic Reputation. Dentistry scored a perfect 100% on the citations element of the rankings confirming the globally leading work that is being carried out, published and having a real impact on improving global health. The Institute was ranked 1<sup>st</sup> in the world in 2020 and 3<sup>rd</sup> in 2021 QS World Rankings for the Citation metric for Dentistry.

### PERSONAL RESEARCH ACTIVITY

My personal expertise lies in the fields of:

- Oral and maxillofacial surgery including oral implantology
- Pain neuroscience
- Systematic review preparation
- Clinical trials

I have influenced clinical practice in the following ways:

- Clinical pain studies developed from systematic reviews have investigated intraoperative local
  analgesia and postoperative systemic analgesic strategies. These studies are crucial in
  providing the evidence for changing clinical practice and improving the pain management for
  patients after surgery and after dental treatment.
- I have written a comprehensive series of Oral Implant Cochrane Systematic Reviews that provide a reliable summary of the global scientific evidence for best practice and the foundation for future implant research.
- I was PI for two international multi-centre studies that demonstrated equivalent healing with a
  novel octylcyanoacrylate tissue adhesive compared to traditional alternatives such as sutures
  for the skin closure of long surgical incisions. This has significant implications in changing the
  400-year-old clinical practice of wound closure with sutures. With adhesives there is no risk of
  needlestick injury and there are no sutures to remove for the patient.
- Working with Dental Public Health I initiated regional Oral Surgery (OS) Referral Triage. An
  Online Referral Management and Triage System for all dental specialist referrals has been
  established and is being evaluated for use across England (£670K NIHR award).
- I developed the Indicator of Sedation Need (IOSN) tool to support clinicians in their decision making and also commissioners who need to identify patients who need conscious sedation for dental treatment in order to plan and deliver appropriate sedation services. This is incorporated in many Referral Management Systems across England and Wales.
- I have established a key position in the strategy for UK oral and maxillofacial surgeons and dentists in responding to domestic violence. Following a systematic review, and local research projects I am currently undertaking an NIHR funded trial to explore domestic violence and the response of dentistry (£250K NIHR award).
- I have established the, 'Barts Centre for Squamous Cancer', to increase research capacity
  into common pathways of genomic, transcriptomic and clinical significance across squamous
  cancers from different tissues though a novel strategic collaborative approach (£2.6m Barts
  Charity).

- I am an advocate of education with a commitment to evidence-based care. My mission has
  been to produce clinical practitioners who are research thinking and public health thinking. I
  regularly lead theatre events for UG BDS and BSc students and small group teaching for MSc
  students on Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. I have been engaged in clinical teaching of UGs

# STATEMENT ON CLINICAL SERVICE

- As a clinical academic I believe that I have a unique opportunity to improve the quality of
  patient care because of my own research involvement and ready access to the research of
  others that can be applied to the management of patients in a controlled and audited way.
  Development and implementation of the wider issues of clinical governance to ensure the
  provision of safe standards of patient care are part of my own mission as a clinical academic.
  These require leadership and appropriate supervision that I strive to provide for the clinicians
  for whom I have responsibility.
- I have provided complex oral surgery care to patients with secondary/tertiary referral from the North West Region. My personal caseload was patients with congenitally absent teeth/associated tissues or who following cancer surgery or trauma require reconstruction with bone graft surgery (especially hip graft) and advanced oral implant surgery. I have provided 5 NHS PAs/week that include clinics, operating sessions (day-case and major in-patient) and a teaching ward round. I had 24-hour responsibility for the patients on my clinical trials. In addition, tertiary referral oral implant clinics held jointly with restorative dentistry and orthodontic consultant colleagues are held monthly. I reduced this commitment to 3 NHS PAs/week on appointment as Vice Dean and Head of the School of Medical Sciences at Manchester University.
- I maintain an Honorary Consultant in Oral Surgery contract at Barts Health NHS Trust. I also undertake a limited clinical private practice at 94 Harley Street, London. I have undertaken medicolegal practice since 2002 providing the majority of my reports for the prosecution.

#### **CLINICAL TRAINING**

- Higher surgical training from 1993 to 2000 with consultant training by Mr R J Middlehurst, Prof J P Rood, Mr A A Quayle, Dr I Hindle and Mr B T Musgrove and Mr R Lloyd. Surgical training included dentoalveolar, pre-prosthetic including implant surgery, orthognathic, salivary gland, temporomandibular joint, facial trauma surgery, and in-patient care of oncology patients.

After becoming head of academic oral and maxillofacial surgery I ceased to participate in the on-call rota although continued to be available for the out of hours clinical management of my own in-patients, administrative
